### CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

#### April 10, 2011 Following Worship

There are two items for the meeting: The first is to vote on Faith United Church of Christ adopting the following :

- **Open & Affirming Statement:**

*“Faith United Church of Christ believes that everyone is loved equally by God. Therefore, we affirm all people, welcoming unconditionally those of every race, ethnicity, background, ability, gender identity, and sexual orientation, reaching out to embrace diversity as we grow together in the light and love of Christ.”*

If this statement is approved by 75% of the congregation, we will become recognized as an open & affirming church.

You may vote on the ONA statement at the meeting, by paper ballots that will be distributed shortly, or you may email the Church office with your yes/no vote decision if you have no privacy concerns. Please remember that the ballots or emails must be returned or received at the Church office prior to the meeting, that is by Friday, April 8th at 11:00 AM.

- **Financial Decision Based Upon Our Budget**

We will also be discussing what actions the members of the church wish to take regarding our continued monetary shortage. Our revised estimated shortage for 2011 is \$28,170. We will soon be unable to pay our bills if we do not cut our costs significantly. The Board of Governors is preparing cost reduction proposals and will provide them to you prior to the meeting.

The majority of the congregation will need to agree on a course of action so the Board of Governors may implement your desires in this matter.

Decisions, Decisions.....

Each and every day, from moment to moment we are assaulted with opportunity. Opportunities that will impact our lives. Some decisions we make are less impactful than others. Our choice of breakfast cereal is clearly less momentous than picking someone to spend our lives with.

I wager there are few among us who do not have some level of connection with the 1882 magazine publication of the short story, *The Lady or the Tiger*. In the story, there are two clear choices, albeit they are obscured by the presence of two doors. The choice of door will serve to be the determinant of an accused man's guilt or innocence....and his living or dying.

Behind one door is a beautiful woman who has been selected by the semi-despotic king to become the bride of the accused. The other door hides a tiger who will devour the prisoner if he so chooses.

On this particular occasion, the king's daughter was caught in a dalliance with the accused, and it is he who faces the life and death decision. One small complication is that the princess knows what lurks behind each door and is in a position to point the love of her life in the right direction. Does she turn him into an entrée for the tiger or a betrothed for the princess?

After worship on Sunday, April 10, we have a couple of phenomenal opportunities set before us. The first is our vote to become an Open and Affirming congregation within the UCC. A positive, especially unanimous vote in that direction will be life affirming and spiritually nourishing for us. Officially and openly embracing all of God's people as citizens of God's realm is just the right thing to do.

Hard choices, momentous decisions. The Lady or the Tiger.....real life or something else. Let's not squander this opportunity. Let's choose well.

Board of Governors Meeting  
March 15, 2011**

Present: Pastor Len West, Mark Sulloway, Fred Damianos, M.R. Lembright, Barbara Brownell, Marge Hooie, Pete Groth, Janis Groth, Bruce Covey, Debra Barnard, Dick Sluss, Joan Beach, Judy Wetter and Ina Bingham.

The meeting was opened at 7:12 PM with prayer by Pastor Len.

The minutes for the February 8, 2011 meeting were approved.

**Financial Secretary Report:** Marge reported that we are down about \$1000 in March for the operating fund and we are \$5300 short for the year for the building fund.

**Treasurer's Report:** Pete reported that we need roughly \$25,000 more to balance the budget and that we need to reduce expenses. Discussion regarding our financial woes took place. Fred made the following motion, seconded by Babs: We prepare four budgets with a time certain for implementation: 1. current budget - broke by July 2. eliminate music - \$800 month deficit 3. eliminate music and part time pastor - balanced budget and 4. reduce music and pastor - balanced budget. After a lengthy discussion Fred made a motion, seconded by M.R., to bring option #4 to the congregation as a recommendation. The reduction would take place beginning in May. Motion carried.

**Upcoming events:** ONA statement will be brought to the congregation on April 10 for vote. Those who are not able to attend the meeting must vote by written ballot prior to the vote or by email by Friday, April 8, 2011. Motion by Babs, seconded by Fred: Move that the Board of Governors vote to approve the ONA statement and send it forth to the congregation for their approval with the recommendation to pass it. Motion carried. A second motion by Babs, seconded by Dick: Move that ONA statement must have 75% yes vote to pass. Motion carried.

M.R. and Babs have been working on a church wide survey. Money to cover the cost of the survey has been donated. The time frame for completing the survey is two weeks.

There will be a training session on Saturday, April 16 from 9 to 3 for all members interested in leadership training led by Jeannette Sherrill from the conference. Jeannette is donating her time.

**Pastor's Report:** Len reported that five people attended the first Adult Bible study last Sunday. He discussed the UCC annual meeting, Synod and his weekly report. He shared his three SMART goals with the Bd.: 1. Faith School of Music and the Arts, 2. Stewardship support in the form of grant writing and 3. Marketing/ Publicity supported by a Laity Team.

**Secretary's Report:** Judy reported that it costs \$200 for a space in the Memorial Garden. Motion by Babs, seconded by M.R.; Move that there will be a \$200 charge for the cost of cremains, whether buried or spread, in the Memorial Garden, The money is to be used for upkeep of the memorial garden. Motion passed.

**Committee Reports:**

**Ministry:** Pastoral Relations Committee met on March 6. Len will be on vacation from April 26 through May 3. He also asked for help setting up for the Lenten series on Wednesday evening.

**Christian Education:** Debra announced that Vacation Bible School will be held from June 23-25 from 5:30 to 8:00 and 9:00-12:00 on Saturday. The starter kit costs \$155. There will be an Easter Egg hunt on April 24. There will be a youth salad bar after church on March 27.

**Building and Grounds:** Dick reported that someone needed to do community service and that person painted the church sign & fixed the ruts in the lawn. On April 9 there will be a church work day. A pipe broke in the sprinkler system and needs to be fixed.

**Faith Women:** Babs announced that the bylaws have been suspended until December and that monthly meetings will be held by different women taking charge each month.

**Social Action and Mission:** Babs announced that SAM will be helping Migrant Services this year. Paper goods will be collected from March-May, underwear and socks from June-Aug and food for migrant families will be ongoing. Babs made a motion, seconded by M.R. to allow Manatee County Schools to hold English classes for migrant families in our facility for a two hour period each week. Motion carried.

**Congregational Involvement:** M.R. announced that Bylaws and Department and Committee consolidation will take place with the help of Jeanette Sherrill.

**Stewardship:** Mark will prepare a financial email.

The meeting closed with prayer at 10:45 by Pastor Len.

The next meeting will be held on April 12 at 7PM.

## CHOIR HAPPENINGS

We are now well into Lent, beginning with Ash Wednesday and the anthems of “Change My Heart, O God” and “Ashes,” to help set the tone of the Lenten season. The music has taken on a more plaintive and somber tone done in a minor key, such as Bach’s “When Thou Art Near” and “If Thou But Suffer God to Guide Thee” on Ash Wednesday, Chopin’s Prelude in E Minor, Beethoven’s “Adagio,” and the more contemporary “Lonely Voices” as the postlude on the first Sunday in Lent. On the second Sunday in Lent the music continued the somber tone with Wely’s “Andante Sostenuto” and Scarlatti’s “Sonata in D Minor.” The music will continue to convey the serious mood of Lent until Palm Sunday with Jesus’ joyous entry in Jerusalem with “Hosanna” and Faure’s “The Palms” as the anthem, and break out into joyful song on Easter with “Rejoice in the Lord Always” and the “Halleluia Chorus” from Handel’s Messiah.

The new Introit each month is working out well. The congregation is joining vigorously in the singing of the Introit every Sunday as we sing it through twice. It is helping to focus attention on the service at the beginning by singing “Lord, Listen to Your Children Praying” and

“Come, Now is the Time to Worship.” In April we will be singing “O How He Loves You and Me” for the first two Sundays, “Hosanna” on Palm Sunday, and “Rejoice in the Lord Always” on Easter.

The special music that has been introduced has been well received, and we are grateful to congregation members who have offered their talents to enhance the worship service. On March 20, Kirt Jones provided a beautiful rendition on the piano of Durand’s “Chaconne,” and on March 20, Peter Groth sang a moving “The Holy City” by Weatherly/Adams, both generating loud applause from the congregation. We look forward to continuing the practice of special music at least once a month, and put out a call for any member who has a vocal or instrumental talent to come forward and offer that talent to the congregation during a worship service.

I have met a number of members of the congregation and look forward to meeting everyone over the next several weeks. I am pleased with the feedback I have received regarding the musical program, and welcome positive input from the congregation to continue improving the musical program.

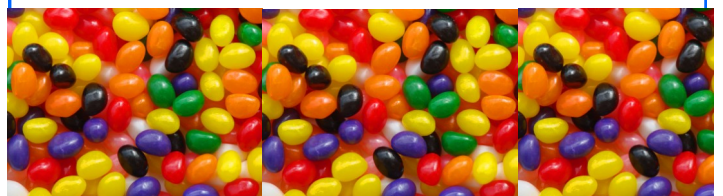
