From the Pastor's Desk.....

The Advent Season is upon us again! Where does time go? The meaning of Advent is "to come." Our time is here again for Jesus' coming into our lives and the life of our church. How blessed we are by this, especially as we look to a new calendar year with a new organization to implement, but a less certain future as to having enough money and people to keep us going in 2012.

One of the ways we will go forward is to look at our lineage...our history and background...and see what it is that makes us strong and energetic and what it is that makes us strong and energetic and what it is that weakens us and needs changing. This advent we will focus on Jesus' lineage and see the kind of background he had. Jesus' ancestors and parents were truly faith-oriented people, but we will see them flaws and all. We can compare ourselves and our background to that of Jesus. I believe it will give us a great experience.

The first week of Advent (Nov. 27), we look at the life of Ruth a foreign woman of faith who married Boaz a kinsman (cousin) of her first husband's family. They were the parents of Obed, the father of Jesse who was the father of King David. We will talk about King David on the second Advent Sunday (December 4.)

On the third Sunday (Dec. 11), the youth and young adults will present a special Christmas Play (stay tuned for more details.) Then on December 18 we will hear of Jesus' parents, Mary and Joseph. That only begins our Christmas celebration! On Christmas eve (Saturday, December 24) we will celebrate Jesus' birth with a service of lessons, candles and carols (Doesn't our sanctuary always look and feel inspiring with all the candles lit for the coming of Jesus?)

Christmas morning (Dec. 25th – a Sunday this year) we will celebrate the day by coming to church "as we are" – in pajamas, sweat suits, slippers, whatever. We will share Christmas stories from our past and exchange gifts under the Christmas tree (wrapped items costing no more than \$3.)

Don't miss a minute of this year's Advent and Christmas celebrations (more action items throughout the FOLLOWER.) That new birth of faith awaits you and all at Faith United Church of Christ!!

As a post script – our New Year's Day service will feature a discussion of our resolutions for our church in the next year, 2012, along with Holy Communion. Be here for that!!

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS
NOVEMBER 14, 2011

Present: Mark Sulloway, Pastor Fred Rhines, Marge Hooie, Judy Wetter, Dick Sluss, Barbara Brownell, M. R. Lembright, Pete Groth, Janis Groth, Bruce Covey, Heather Reardon, Kaitlyn Morrell, Ina Bingham, Fred Damianos and Kaye McGregor.

The meeting was opened at 7:05 PM with a prayer by Pastor Fred.

The Minutes for the October meeting were approved.

Financial Secretary Report: Marge reported that collections for the Operating Fund for October 2011 had gone down by \$3219. So far in November the Operating Fund is down \$2553. For November \$1285.91 is needed for the mortgage payment.

Treasurers Report: Pete Groth reported that after bills are paid there will be a \$5366.48 balance in the Operating Fund.

Upcoming events include decorating the church for Christmas on November 26, Christmas Tea on December 3, Pot Luck and cookie exchange on December 10 and the Christmas play on December 11.

Pastor's Report: In October Pastor Fred made 13 phone calls and 11 visits for a total of 24 contacts to church members. During Lent he will preach on the lineage of Jesus. The Christmas morning service will be "come as you are casual". More information will follow.

Secretary's Report: Judy has provided information on a lease program on a new Cannon copier. It was moved and supported to lease this copier. It will save \$110 per month.

Committee Reports

Ministry: Bruce said plans are being made for advent and decorating the church.

Christian Education: Thirteen pies were sold for Thanksgiving. The children will sing once a month in the Sunday service. The Youth and Young Adults will be in charge of a potluck and cookie exchange on December 10 at 5 PM The group is looking into doing a contemporary service on Saturday evenings.

Preschool: Currently there are 7 children in the Tuesday and Thursday class and 8 in the Monday, Wednesday and Friday class. There are 12 in the VPK program.

Buildings and Grounds: Dick Sluss is fixing some outside lights.

SAM- Barb Brownell said 103 items were collected for the Food Bank for November. The children will start carrying food into the church and place by the altar on Sunday once a month.

Congregational Involvement: The Report on the Survey Responses will be in the Follower. Long range goals will be addressed throughout the year by the board. Judy will review the membership list and send a list of members who have not attended lately so board members can contact them.

Stewardship: Mark and M.R. will give a message before each service for the next few weeks.

Endowment: Fred has not received any calls.

Old Business: Income increasing ideas include selling part of the property, share the church facility with another congregation and various fund raisers. We closed the safe deposit box and Ina has a fireproof box she will provide for the church.

The meeting closed at 9:55 PM with a prayer by Pastor Fred.

The next regular meeting will be on Monday, December 12 at 7:00 PM

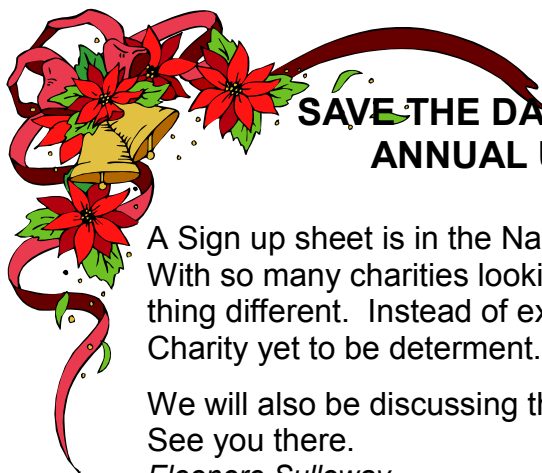

Faith Church Votes to Establish a CHURCH COUNCIL for 2012

We are trying a more flexible and more focused format for church governance for the year 2012!!

- CHURCH COUNCIL is the new name of our governing organization.
- There are NEW TITLES for church leaders: Moderator, Deputy Moderator, Team Leaders or Co-Leaders.
- What were Board of Governor's Departments and Committees have been REORGANIZED into TEAMS.
- Teams have NEW NAMES that better identify their area of responsibility.
- Team responsibilities include specific tasks as listed on the Church Council Outline.
- The Council Moderator takes on responsibility for supervision of the paid staff. The Deputy Moderator is responsible for personnel relations, specifically the Pastoral Relations Committee and the Music Committee.
- Additional Council Leader responsibilities are listed in the top right corner of the Church Council outline.
- Council members are those who have VOLUNTEERED FOR A SPECIFIC POSITION. Council members will then be elected to their positions at the Annual Meeting of the Congregation.
- Terms of office for Council members is one year at this time.
- Each Team Leader will have responsibility for inviting members and friends of Faith to become members of their Team either for the year OR persons may choose to volunteer on that team just for specific activities.

Report on Mission 1

A global mission event by the UCC ended on Nov 11, but the work continues!

Faith was part of an international campaign to focus on issues of hunger worldwide. For 11 days in the eleventh month of 2011, our church joined with many UCC churches to collect food items, write letters to our leaders and donate money to help feed the hungry. The challenge was huge: 1 million items of food, 11,111 letters to Congress and \$111,111 donated to both Neighbors in Need and African Famine Relief.

How did we do?

1,373,171 food items have been donated. (Faith UCC donated 103.)

36,794 letters have been written to Congress \$105,983 has been donated to African Famine Relief and

\$102,557 has been donated to Neighbors In Need. Faith's Youth donated \$137.00

And the money, food donations and letters are still coming! Thanks to all Faith UCC members who participated, and especially to the youth and young adults who made it a special project.

We will continue to collect food items in the months of November and December in order to put together holiday baskets for those in need.

Board of Governors Report on Survey Responses

The following are highlights of congregational responses to our survey. Basically, the Board of Governors is reporting on what 44% of Faith Church members and friends told us. The survey responses reflect a wide diversity of opinion and viewpoints which are often polarized. While diversity can often be beneficial, polarization challenges our ability to define and focus on our common purpose.

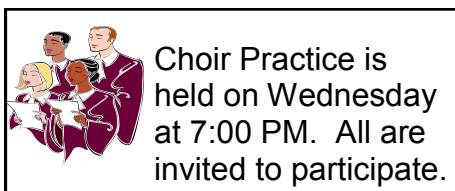
Survey responders:

- clearly stated a desire for improved communication and more transparency from the Board.
- expressed concern that there were not enough different people involved in leadership and programming.
- expressed concern that people with minority viewpoints have in the past been treated unkindly or with disrespect.
- affirmed our emphasis on God, faith, and social issues as a focus of worship.
- desire more year-round activities at church.
- expressed a desire to simplify and make more effective our governing board.
- are divided on how well individual members respond to and manage change in church traditions and programs.
- A surprising number (35%) of church responders indicated that they did not know if the church was active in and concerned enough with missions. About the same number want more local and UCC missions involvement.
- Only a quarter of our responders think that our Christian Education programs for adults are meaningful and interesting. However a high number of respondents thought highly of our programs for youth and children.
- Half of respondents did not reply to questions about social action issues and whether our church should be involved in them.

The Board of Governor's members have adopted comprehensive immediate action plans and long term goals that address the concerns of the congregation. The Board of Governors has also adopted immediate action plans and long term goals that relate to areas of church life that are of special concern to the BOG.

We received a great deal of information from survey responders. Reminder: all survey responses may be read by visiting the church office during office hours or by contacting M.R. Lembright, Barbara Brownell or Mark Sulloway.

Members of the BOG ask that you come to us directly to offer your ideas, opinions and concerns so that we can all work together to make Faith Church a community where each of us finds growth and affirmation.
