
With all this in mind, I want to

The church growth committee has tabulated our survey about becoming an even more welcoming church. The committee reviewed the numeric survey results below as well as all the comments and shared them with the Church Council with recommendations.

After consulting with the Church Growth Committee the Council decided to do the following:

1. **Keep all Pre-Service Changes and the Move of the Greeting** Council noted these all have clear positive scores. We are going to enhance the 15 minute meditation music by lighting candles during the music and eliminate announcements (just have "Music for Meditation") so people get a clear sense that some have already started worship.
- 2) **Reinstate a "Welcome," the Doxology & occasionally the Mission Statement** We will add back a brief greeting from the Pastors to all and especially visitors. We will also occasional use the Mission Statement in worship. **The Doxology** was missed by a number of members, so we are putting it back in the service.
- 3) **Holding Hands** had strong scores on both sides. After much discussion, the council has decided to not hold hands and also not use "Let There Be Peace" to eliminate confusion and sending a mixed message
- 4) There were many comments about the **Music at Faith** and a need to improving it per our Dreams and Visions. Because we still lack enough financial strength to hire musicians, Council is forming a permanent Music Committee to coordinate and maximize the use of our own congregation's talents (see article about "Praise Choir"). As finances improve we may consider seeking out college or High School students as a first step.

Thank you for your feedback and your participation in this experiment in welcoming. We know that some of the changes are hard, but we want to continue to make sure we do all we can to make us as welcoming as possible. To that end the Council has asked the Church Growth Committee to continue to explore ways to bring more people to this wonderful community of faith!

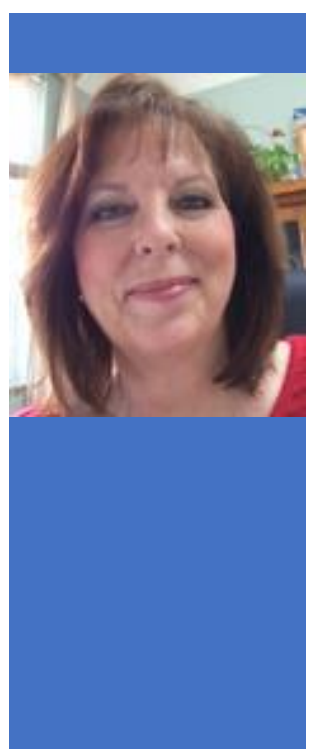

CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

Faith United Church of Christ /// March 14, 2016

PRESENT: Faith Quici, Marge Hooie, Barbara Brownell, Robin Wentz, Pastor Jude, Pastor Brian, Deb D'Angelo, Jim Willard, Linda Anderson, Richard Dilts, Denny Wetter, and Judy Wetter.

The meeting was called to order by the moderator,

Marge Hooie and an opening prayer was given by Pastor Jude. A motion to accept the minutes of February was given by Judy Wetter and second by Deb D'Angelo. The motion was carried unanimously.

FINANCIAL SECRETARY'S REPORT: For the month of February Judy deposited \$10,739.20 into the Bank of America operating account \$391.00 into the Bank of the Ozarks building for the future account and \$451.00 in the Bank of the Ozarks pass through account for a total deposit of \$11,581.70.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Jim reported that he has been trudging along with Quickbooks and the bills are getting paid, but the whole system really needs to be straightened out. Jim and Pastor Brian will look into the best method to get either Quickbooks going or Church Windows and will get someone to help get whichever one is better, set up.

PASTOR'S REPORT: Pastor Brian reported that 4 people have asked about joining so he will hold a new member class on April 10th and they will join on April 17th. The potluck will be April 3rd at the beach service. Pastor Jude reported that the book class started with 20 people and 19 will finish. There were 5 "outsiders" and of those 2 want to join and 1 is thinking about it, the other 2 belong to other churches. Pastor Jude will be meeting with the GLBTs of the church to brainstorm about the wants and needs in the community. She has also been doing some pastoral counseling and hospital visits. Pastor Brian said

that Gary would be willing to give a class on couples and communication. A social media and iPhone class has been set for April. Pastor Brian also said that the ball was dropped regarding the riverwalk pride festival which will be held this weekend but he will see if there is any way to get a table or booth in it.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Faith talked to Wendi about the smoke smell in the back room and she said she does smell it but opens the room up and febrezes. Faith will put an ad in the follower to see if anyone has an air cleaner collecting dust that they would like to donate. Faith also met with Wendi regarding the cleaning issues. They met with John and Faith put up a check list and so far it's good. The \$200.00 charge that the website developers were charging has been dropped. Faith reported that it was getting close to the time to get a new lease for the copier. A few people have been by to try to sell theirs. Judy said she would go with Faith to check some of these companies out in order to make a good recommendation to the board.

OLD BUSINESS: Beach service April 3rd with a possible baptism. Growth committee tabulated the survey results. They would like to present the results to the church. Barbara Brownell made a motion to accept the committee's recommendations. Robin seconded the motion, which was carried by a unanimous vote. One of the recommendations was regarding a music committee. It was said that we need a committee to make the most of the talent we have at the church. Judy Wetter volunteered to chair that committee.

NEW BUSINESS: Church women United will be meeting April 1st at St. Paul's Missionary Baptist Church.

Dinner and dessert will be at the Outback and then dessert at the Groths'. There is no one signed up for April at the present time. Sheryl Smith volunteered to do hospitality after Easter service. The potluck for March was canceled and the potluck for April will be at the beach.

DEPARTMENTS:

Building and Grounds: Denny Wetter presented his report of the efforts to keep the church in good shape. He mentioned that service master has completed the restoration work and is waiting on a final inspection by the insurance company. The complete report can be found in the follower.

Pastoral Relations: The PRC will likely meet in April.

Community Outreach: Deb D'Angelo is preparing ads for social media and iPhone classes.

SAM: One great hour of sharing was Sunday Strengthen the Church will be in June. Barbara asked for diapers (newborn especially) for women at her facility as well as for the yellow bin in the narthex.

Worship: Richard Dilts asked if communion could be moved to the second Sunday in April since the first Sunday we will be at the beach. Barbara requested a spotter to keep an eye out for inunction, and Richard requested volunteers for communion. Deb volunteered to assist Richard, and Robin will be the spotter for April. Easter lilies will be ordered Wednesday and delivered on the 25th.

Closing prayer was given by Pastor Brian.
