Important PRC Recommendation

At the Nov. 8 Congregational Informational Meeting, the Pastoral Relations Committee recommended exploring a Co-Pastorate structure for our church. Early in Pastor Brian's interviews with the Search Committee, he mentioned that one of his hopes was to be able to share congregational ministry with his wife, Rev. Jude Bagley-Bonner, if and when it became possible. The Search Committee, though unable to make any particular commitment, indicated their openness to explore this as a possibility someday.

Jude and Brian envision sharing one position so this would not demand any additional financial expenditures. One possible way to do this would be for Brian to **continue year round as a pastoral presence while Jude would be present from Sept to June and** would be involved in **co-leading** Sunday service and preach at least once a month. She would also utilize her gifts in spiritual life programming to lead small groups, and in helping our **church grow— an area she has a great deal of experience in.** This would give Brian a chance to work on outreach, utilizing media and the internet. Having some of the weekly duties shared also means Brian could give more energy to working on gaining new members and congregational support/care.

Faith UCC is at a critical point. The church cannot continue the status quo of relying on space rental to support nearly a quarter of the budget. More than ever, we need to place focused attention on Church Growth. We also need increased programming. Concentrated efforts in these two areas will help us strengthen our church both numerically and spiritually and will allow us to pursue our Dreams and Visions more successfully. The change from a solo pastor to a co-pastorate will require a vote of the congregation so your feedback is needed. The PRC supports this concept and presented it to the Church Council, which voted to work further on a timeline for implementation if the church voted to hire Jude and Brian as a co-pastors. We encourage all members and friends of this congregation to talk with any of us about your ideas and thoughts.

- Replaced Light Bulbs Narthex, Sanctuary & Exterior
- Coordinated Shutter Repair in Sanctuary & blinds in Narthex
- Installed new sprinkler line and several new heads in Zone #1. System reactivated to auto.
- Replaced Exterior main entrance light & returned former 5 month old light for partial refund.
- Repaired vandalism to the Dumpster Fence.
- Coordinated & oversaw AC 6 month maintenance with Cool Today. Discussed musty odor from AC & condensation problem in outside storage area. Agreed on increasing airflow on this unit by increasing fan speed. Consideration of installing larger belts and expanding capacity of storage room duct work if condensation/musty odor continue. Fan speed increased November 3 with improved air flow and static pressure. Will revisit larger belts & duct work expansion if problem persist.
- Reset clocks & timers for fall.

Present: Judy Wetter, Barbara Brownell, Pastor Brian, Sheryl Smith, Deb D'Angelo, Richard Dilts, Faith Quici, Marge Hooie, Marge Critelli, Robin Wentz and Linda Anderson. The meeting was brought to order at 7:06 with a prayer led by Pastor Brian.

A motion to accept the minutes from the October meeting was made by Robin Wentz and 2nd by Deb D'Angelo.

FINANCIAL SECRETARY'S

REPORT: Marge Hooie reported that the deposits for the month of October were \$8,456.50 for the operating fund to the Bank of America, \$379.90 to the pass through account and \$310.00 for the building fund both at the Bank of the Ozarks.

TREASURER'S REPORT: \$740.00 was sent to the conference for OCWM. We still owe \$1260.00. We were also billed for \$1350.00 for per capita which is our \$14.50 yearly dues to conference for each member. Judy will send emails out to remind people that this is owed annually by each member.

PASTOR'S REPORT: New member class will be held December 7 with each member joining on December 14. There are potentially 6 people interested in joining the church at that time. The open and affirming task force reported that over 1000 UCC churches have become open and affirming. Saturday is the "money in church" seminar which Marge Hooie and Pastor Brian will be attending. The pastor talked about a challenge that a former church did which involved the church giving people \$50.00 and told to "grow" the money in a 6 month time frame. Some sold things, some invested, some sold services etc. but it received a lot of press and was very beneficial for the church.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Life Touch Photography is scheduled for 1/27/15 and 1/28/15. A decision needs to be made if we are going to do this and who's going to organize it.

OLD BUSINESS: Deb D'Angelo will look at their schedule and decide if they can host dinner and dessert for December. Janice and Pete Groth will

host January's. Auction: since the auction has been changed to January the wreath Judy made won't be appropriate since it's a Christmas wreath. She will do a silent auction for it at the church. Stewardship plan: 5 cards were received yesterday in the offering. Pastor Relation's committee report: timeline was given for co-pastorate vote. Babs motioned on behalf of the pastoral relation committee to accept and implement the timeline with the ultimate goal of voting on it at the annual meeting and hopefully having a co-pastorate with Pastors Brian and Judy Bagley Bonner. Robin 2nd the motion and the motion was carried unanimously. There will be a Thanksgiving service with the apostolic church the Sunday prior to Thanksgiving. Community Thanksgiving: there wasn't much response from the churches and synagogues so we will let it go until next year and if there isn't any response form the Congregational Church we won't have a Thanksgiving eve service. Judy looked into the Jim Russo ministry. The house is able to house 8 men who are just out of the prison system. They are expected to pay \$440/month for a room after the 1st month. The request is to sponsor a room @ \$500.00 which buys furniture for 1 man. After some discussion it was decided to table this for the present time. It is generally preferred that people apply for mission money.

NEW BUSINESS: For the internment regulations it was motioned by Robin to remove the word "minor" from the regulation and add domestic partner. The motion was 2nd by Sheryl. The motion was carried with a unanimous vote. Nominating committee: Babs asked that council members let her know if they plan to remain in their present position. Mission Money: Brian would like to get designated mission money in an account by itself and is recommending CD's at the cornerstone. The discussion will be

tabled until next month. Budget: Marge will have the budget for 2015 by the next meeting. Fundraisers: Bob Evans, Lee Roy Selman's and Applebee's will donate a percentage of the total bill if they are notified in advance of the date. This might be a good consideration for dinner and dessert in the future. Backpacks: The \$250 matching dollars was if we put backpack kits together. It was decided to just send the \$250 collected for them to put towards kits.

DEPARTMENTS AND

COMMITTEES: Building and grounds: The crew replaced bulbs, coordinated the shutter repair, installed new sprinkler line, repaired vandalism to the dumpster fence and worked on the musty smell coming from one of the AC & condensation problem in outside storage area. Upcoming is the word day on November 22. Christian Ed: Earleen and Hattie doing nicely with younger kids and occasionally one or two of the older kids. Church Events and Fellowship: Sheryl reports that Jack Williams' service was very nice. She would like to encourage people to attend the Apostolic Thanksgiving dinner and service and bring a dessert. Christmas potluck will be December 14th. Community Outreach: Deb doesn't have anything to report at this time. SAM: Habitat Sunday collected \$337.00 and \$150.00 in Jack Williams name. It was motioned by Babs that the \$800 from the former women's fellowship money be combined with the Thornton's mission money, minus \$300 for the pastor's discretionary fund. Deb second the motion which was carried with a unanimous vote. Worship: Richard said the poinsettias will be delivered December 17th. Babs offered to set them up after the preschool play. The flier will go in the bulletin this Sunday. Undecorating of the church will be January 6th or 7th. The meeting was adjourned at 9:14 with a closing prayer by Babs.
