## Dear People of Faith,

As I settle into co-pastoring with Brian, I have been working with the Pastoral Relations Committee to establish goals for my first year of work. As you know, my work will primarily focus on the goal of church growth. Having developed these goals, we wanted to share them with you so you know what I am doing.

### 1. Set parameters for work

- Work with church leaders to develop official job description that ensures clear focus on Church Growth.
- Establish Church Growth Committee and Small Group Steering Committee by March 1.

### 2. Ensure that twelve new members join Faith UCC in 2015

- Learn local, community newspapers for advertizing as well as article submission (devotionals, essays, etc.) Submit four articles by April 1, June 1, Oct 1, and Dec 31.
- Establish and market to wider community, four small

groups; two this winter, two in Fall 2015.  
-Continue to develop and consistently utilize current method of follow-up to first time visitors by April.

-Preach about the challenges and blessings of church growth by June 1.

-Attend UCC Florida Conference or other training on development of spiritual growth groups by end of calendar year.

-Read two new books on small group ministries by Sept 1.

### 3. Foster pastoral rapport with current members

- Visit with each household individually, one per week until accomplished.

While these goals do not represent the sum total of what I will be doing, they at least give you an idea of the direction of my work. I am excited to be moving ahead with you in mutual ministry.

## Growing Pains

It is so nice to see the pews full and more children in Sunday School. We have been able to fulfill some of our Dreams and Visions. We are growing! We are finding success!! And now the problems begin - Wait, what? As playwright Noel Coward noted above, success has its own issues. Though God has brought us through difficult times of financial vulnerability and too few people, we cannot rest on our success, because we now face a new set of good, but still challenging issues.

Church growth gurus talk about congregations moving from "family" churches to "town" churches and I think we are in that transition. In the past few years, Faith UCC has been a family church. Pretty much everyone knows everyone else and everyone has their niche. One does the kitchen, another does the ushering, this person makes decisions on the music. In a "family" church, just like in my family, everyone is on the same page and so anyone's decision at any one time is ok. Everyone knows and trusts one another. A way to envision this is to think about the times uncles or aunts would correct us at family gatherings. They would be able to talk to us with the same authority as parents because we were a family.

In contrast, someone from the other side of town would not be able to say anything to us, because they are from a different family and have different understandings and values. Because of this, towns have newspapers and town meetings to increase communication; rules and organized committees to make sure everyone's needs are addressed and concerns heard; and people to direct traffic or mediate differences when issues arise. So one of our tasks in 2015 is to

grow into a "town." We will focus on finishing our reorganization process and make sure we have the committees and communication processes in place to make good decisions and move forward together. This means we will have to be patient with one another and adjust how we implement ideas or changes.

Sometimes addressing issues and making changes will take longer, but a careful process of decision making with good communication will ensure the best outcome. And it will remind us that we are not about efficiency in decision making, but about love, - making sure everything we do is done with the same love and patience that God shows us. And so we asking for your patience as we continue this journey together. The two of us are still figuring out how we are going to work together. And we are trying to remember that God has invited us to a grand adventure where sometimes things will succeed and sometimes they will fail miserably, but we will never be bored. I leave you with another quote, which may be a good guide for 2015 as we continue to try new things and grow together as a community of faith:

"I don't think we have failed, we have just found another way that doesn't work."

(refreshments of your Choice)

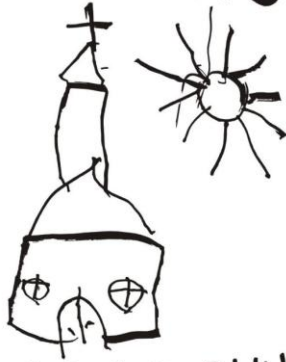

#### Work completed:

1. Rented signal detector and found location of 7 of 8 sprinkler valves, including #6 which is jammed open.
2. Prepared one internment site and closed it.
3. Worked on toilets that won't stop flushing.
4. Repaired memorial garden security camera.

#### Expenditures:

1. Rental on detector \$47.93.

#### Scheduled work:

1. Dig up #6 sprinkler valve and see if it can be repaired or will need to be replaced. Estimated replacement cost \$50 to \$75.
2. Install new "Safe Place" sign for pre-school.
3. Investigate low water pressure to toilets.
4. Cover security camera wires in office.

**Present:** Deb D'Angelo, Barbara Brownell, Marge Hooie, Pastor Judy Bagley-Bonner, M.R. Lembright, Judy Wetter, Richard Dilts, Faith Quici, Pastor Brian Bagley-Bonner, Marge Critelli and Linda Anderson. The meeting was called to order at 7:08 by Marge Hooie and with a prayer from Pastor Brian. A motion to accept the minutes of the January meeting was made by Barbara Brownell and second by Marge Critelli. The motion was carried with a unanimous vote.

**Financial Secretary's Report:** Judy reported that a total of \$11,781.65 was deposited to the Bank of America "operating account" during the month of January, a total of \$295.00 was deposited to the Bank of the Ozarks "Building for the future account" and a total of \$1,713.16 was deposited to the Bank of the Ozarks "pass through account".

**Treasurer's Report:** Marge Critelli presented the council with the income vs. expenses report. She also reported that the Building for the Future account currently has \$146,238.34, the Operating account has \$6,460.62 and the Pass-Through account has \$2,256.00.

**Pastor's Report:** Music experiment is going well. We had 7 new members join Sunday. Pastor Jude is focusing on establishing her position to foster church growth.

**Secretary's Report:** Calendar for February and March is done. Any changes please let Faith know. Faith thanked everyone for the new computer and is in the process of setting it up. Faith is working on a new brochure for new visitors and will look into pens to advertise the church.

**Old Business:** Life touch webinar was viewed by Judy, Faith and the planning team. If it's done by the 25<sup>th</sup> the church will get bonus books.

Church Windows: the upgrade has been purchased but we haven't received it yet. Dreams and Visions: Pastor Brian said he would get a list of accomplishments together. We also need to resurrect the by-laws committee and get it done. Cornerstone: Marge Critelli closed SAM account and put \$500 of it into the pastor's discretionary fund as agreed and \$536 into a money market. Debbie at Cornerstone updated the rate list. 60 month CD has increased to 3.022% with a minimum of \$10,000.00. A 60 month CD with < \$10,000 is 2%. We have \$20,500 for deposit in 6 month, 12 month, 18 month, 2 year and 5 year. She also discussed the need for signatures on a form to put Marge Critelli on the Cornerstone account. Nursery: Barbara Brownell mentioned the need for more people to staff the nursery.

**New Business:** Dinner and Dessert: A host is needed for dinner and dessert for March. Judy said she would write an article for the follower. Janis Groth said that she would help coordinate dinner and dessert and potluck as long as she is here. Money counters after worship: Judy would like 4-5 people to help count money after service each Sunday. Office for Pastor Jude: The PRC had a discussion during their last meeting regarding the need for Pastor Jude to have her own office space. It was suggested that the choir room become her office and the old youth group room would be the choir area with more space for music, robes, etc. Pastor Brian has discussed this with Bob Cox and he was agreeable to the arrangement. Deb D'Angelo motioned to make the choir room Pastor Jude's office and the old youth room cleaned out for the choir room. Barbara Brownell second the motion which was carried unanimously by the

counsel. New Members Class: Marge Hooie suggested we have current members join the new members class to tell them what they do and how the church runs.

**DEPARTMENT AND COMMITTEE REPORTS: Building and**

**Grounds:** a report was submitted by the committee which will also be in the Follower. They have found all the sprinkler valves, prepared one internment site, worked on the toilets that won't stop flushing and repaired memorial garden security camera.

**Christian Ed:** Hattie and Earleen are in good rhythm.

**Community Outreach:** Nothing to report.

**SAM:** OGHS is in March or April.

**Spiritual Life:** New name – "Faith Care Team". Members will be advocates.

**Worship team:** Flyer for Easter lilies they will be \$8.00. March 29<sup>th</sup> will be the last day to order. March 1<sup>st</sup> communion will be Deb, Judy, Babs, and Marge. April 5<sup>th</sup> communion will be Jude, Richard and Linda.

Closing prayer was giving Pastor Judy.

Motion to adjourn was made by Babs and 2<sup>nd</sup> Deb.
