### TAKE STOCK IN CHILDREN

Jim and I are volunteer mentors for a program called Take Stock in Children.

Take Stock in Children is a volunteer opportunity which matches a volunteer mentor with a middle or high school student. The time component for the volunteer is so small and the reward for the student is HUGE. Volunteers mentor their students for just 30 minutes each week during the school year. The meetings take place at the student's school. Through these meetings, you are helping the student meet one of the three requirements which will result in the student earning a FULL ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP FOR FOUR YEARS OF COLLEGE upon graduation from high school. It is quite the incentive for the student to stay in school, maintain the required grade point average, and stay drug-free and

crime-free. As a student's mentor, you become another person who cares about the student and is there to support the student's academic success.

The program hopes that the mentors stay with their students until high school graduation, but understands if only a one-year commitment can be made. Hundreds of students in this county applied to the program; but due to the funding necessary for the full scholarships, only 24 students were accepted for the next school year. Sad to say, it was difficult to find volunteers for this group of 24. But all 24 are now matched with mentors. Volunteers also have the chance to be part of the selection process. Reading the student applications and learning of the dreams they have for their futures and the odds some must overcome, even daily, will pull many a heart string.

## From the Pastor's Desk

### A Small Change Can Make A Big Difference

Every Sunday in the Bradenton Herald, I came upon the Crime Stoppers page. Here I saw pictures of people who had been arrested with a slash through their face, much like the picture of me above. This troubled me greatly and on May 15th I sent my slashed picture with the following letter to the editor.

*Our culture is in trouble. Young men have died at the hands of law enforcement. The criminal justice system is geared up to incarcerate low income people, including some who battle mental illness or addiction, while "good" upper middle class white collar criminals run free on Wall Street and Main street. One reason this happens is we glorify the rich in our nation and we debase and dehumanize the poor "common" criminal. This division is unconstitutional, unethical and unsustainable. President Abraham Lincoln quoting Scripture said, "A house divided against itself will not stand." With this in mind, I ask the Bradenton Herald to cease printing pictures on the Crime Stoppers page of human beings with slashes through their faces when they have been arrested. This is the type of dehumanizing action which contributes to a culture where it is OK to be a "little rough" with the criminal element. Some of these individuals*

*have done awful things, but they have not stopped being human beings. Nor have they stopped being sons and daughters, mothers and fathers of people in the community who also suffer when they witness the literal defacing of their loved one. A simple check mark beside their name with the large "ARRESTED" above their picture is certainly enough. To adapt one of Jesus' sayings, "Let them who are without sin, make the first slash."*

They did not publish the letter, but I am happy to report that the Bradenton Herald did change their policy and a "thank you" was sent which they did publish. Now the page has no slashed- through pictures, but just the large word "ARRESTED" (see picture below) It is a small thing, but it is the small things which set the tone for our culture and our world. Hatred, resentment and dehumanization grow one teaspoon at a time. I need to write more such letters. They will not all change things, but if I don't write, then I guarantee change won't happen!

Thank you for your support! Faith UCC is a beacon of light to Bradenton!

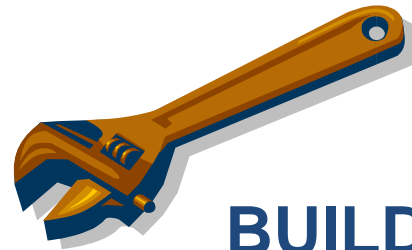

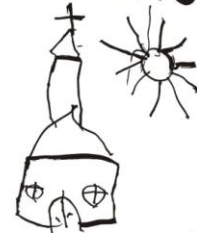

## NEWS FROM FAITH PRESCHOOL

Pastor Brian opened the meeting at 7:03 with a prayer.

A motion was made by Judy to accept the minutes as written in the follower. Marge C. seconds the motion and the motion was carried with a unanimous vote.

#### **FINANCIAL SECRETARY'S**

**REPORT:** Judy gave a report that showed a total deposit in May of \$16,218.79 which included; \$14,974.29 to the Bank of America operating account, \$330.00 to the Bank of the Ozarks building for the future account, and \$314.50 to the Bank of the Ozarks pass through account.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Marge Critelli showed the income and expenses statement for April and May combined (quick books was out of commission in April) with a profit of \$811.06 for the 2 months and a \$198.90 profit year to date.

**PASTOR'S REPORT:** Pastor Brian advised that Pastor Judy is now in Ohio. The Potts' daughter, along with her son, have moved here and been to church the past few Sundays. They are interested in having her parent's remains placed in the memorial garden. Facebook has had almost one thousand viewers and has had a few interested in the transgender study. The church growth committee met before Judy left. They are working on looking at the church like someone new coming in for the first time to see if changes need to be made. They are going to experiment with some comfortable furniture in the narthex to encourage people to socialize before and after church. The committee will be meeting again next week and work at making visitors more comfortable.

**SECRETARY'S REPORT:** Faith was unable to attend but gave the counsel a report on "office happenings". The new pens were ordered and have arrived. The flood was discovered on May 29<sup>th</sup> and our exterior sign was vandalized on June 3<sup>rd</sup>. Several sign companies were called to fix the problem however, there is no good solution at this time. June 4<sup>th</sup> it was noticed that the mailbox was knocked over and we're not sure if it was hit or the wood just rotted. Denny repaired the mailbox.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Life Touch photos update- proof #2 was sent back a month ago and we are waiting on proof #3 to be sent. Richard stated that he agreed about past discussions regarding the organ. He thinks it should be moved out of the church. Robin motioned to put the organ on Craig's list in order to get rid of it and any money made should be put in the music fund. M.R. seconded the motion which was carried with a unanimous vote. Pastor Brian will also contact our sister church in Tampa and Judy suggested asking Manatee Religious Services if they knew of anyone who needed an organ.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Denny Wetter submitted a list of building and contents damages. The insurance company is being very good about fixing everything. We still don't know if we're going to get new carpet. The company the insurance people sent to remove the water has done a very good job. Dinner and Dessert for June 26 will be hosted by Gary and Karin Rosenfeld at the Outback and for July 18<sup>th</sup> it will be hosted by Richard and Jimmy at their house for potluck and pool party. Marge Critelli reported that she is starting to attempt to learn Church Windows but is finding it difficult. After reading the instructions she has more questions than answers.

Judy suggested she and Marge C and Marge H get together and work on it and if needed, an accountant may need to set it up correctly so the church can go from there.

The next pastoral relations meeting will be July 22.

**SAM:** Robin reported that the Strengthen the Church offering will be June 28<sup>th</sup> and this month is rice month for food collection. Neighbors in Need offering will be in October.
